WHO ARE WE?

Studio 410 is an Ontario based Not-for-Profit organization, aiming to deliver arts education to rural areas. Led by musical sisters, Devan and Paige, Studio 410 provides programming to youth to develop performance skills, but more importantly, develops confidence, empathy, kindness and resiliency. Studio 410 strives to inspire their youth to be better artists, and better people.

WHAT IS NOT CANCELLED: THE MUSICAL?

Not Cancelled, the Musical, is a hope-filled all original Canadian song-cycle featuring local youth telling stories of the pandemic. This story developed from the book, Not Cancelled: Canadian Kindness in the face of COVID-19. In a time when it felt like everything from sports gatherings to birthday parties were being cancelled, a realization emerged that important things such as love, kindness, and ingenuity can never be cancelled. This story is a collective heartbeat and history of our nation as we navigated personally and as a whole through these unusual times.

The team at Studio 410 developed original music, scores, choreography and characters, and after the big-screen premiere, are taking the poignant story out into the world to shine a hopeful light on all we've learned, as a reminder on how to grow through adversity, show love when we can, and always lean into the positive.

HOW IT WORKS

Select one of our Q&A timeslots and join us with your class to discuss "Not Cancelled: The Musical"! We will guide your students through a discussion about the themes that are showcased in the show, and we will open the floor to any questions they may have for us about the show, the process, and more! The Q&A session is 30-40 minutes long. Please have questions prepared and ready to go. These sessions are shared with other classes, and we will facilitate the question period through the chat function on Zoom.

Once you have selected your Q&A, and email will be sent to you, including the link for the show, the student workbook and the curriculum connections.
